_____ **1 Corinthians 6:19-20** Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?

Week 3

_____ **Titus 2:11-13** For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men, instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus,

Week 4

_____ **John 15:7** If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

_____ **Psalms 66:18** If I regard wickedness in my heart, The Lord will not hear;
