Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

_____ **1 Corinthians 6:19-20** Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.

Week 3

_____ **Titus 2:11-13** For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, while we wait for the blessed hope—the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ,

_____ **Romans 5:12** Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned.

_____ **Romans 5:8** But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

_____ **Ephesians 4:32** Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

_____ **John 15:7** If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.

Week 3

_____ **Psalms 66:18** If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened;

_____ **Romans 8:28-29** And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.
